Supervisor Payments

All school-based supervisors receive a stipend each semester commensurate with the level of trainee they are supervising

Email Access

The faculty/staff ID card permits supervisors to establish an email account at the university.

Faculty/Staff Identification Card

All supervisors may receive a university faculty/staff ID card. It provides university facility use privileges on a limited basis, including access to UW recreation facilities and unions.
